Boasting three championship golf courses, Peachtree City is a golfer's dream with its green lifestyle and breathtaking vistas.

The Braelinn Golf Club is an 18-hole, Joe Lee-designed course that features beautiful, tree-lined fairways, challenging water features and a variety of bunker challenges. It also features a double-sided driving range as well as a short-game practice area and two full-time golf instructors.

Flat Creek Country Club is a 27-hole venue that features not only a championship golf course, but also a spectacular clubhouse with a capacity in excess of 300. Flat Creek Country Club provides guests access to a fabulous pool and tennis facility. This popular golf course features three diverse nines, a variety of elevation changes and beautiful views of the Flat Creek, which meanders through the course. Flat Creek Country Club also offers a large, double-sided driving range with

both mat and grass hitting areas, targets and premium range balls, as well as a short-game practice area.

The newest of the three clubs, **Planterra Ridge**, an 18-hole golf course, makes it extremely playable regardless of a golfer's skill level, so it's ideas for a range of tournaments. Players of all ages and expertise will enjoy undulating greens and tree-lined fairways. Planterra Ridge Golf Club has a quality driving range, short-game practice area and putting greens available. The clubhouse patio has an amazing view of Lake McIntosh and boasts an outdoor fireplace for events held during cooler temperatures.

While the three **ClubCorp** courses are considered private, the courses work cooperatively with all the Peachtree City hotels, allowing for guests to be able to experience golf at the local courses for a reasonable fee. All tee times will be arranged compliments of your hotel!
